NAMES OF SHIPS	The Discovery, the Susan Constant and the Godspeed	The Mayflower
FOUNDERS/SPONSORS	The London Company	The London Company and Separatists (Pilgrims)
RELIGIONS	mostly Anglican (Church of England)	Protestant groups and Separatists
LEADERS	John Smith John Rolfe	William Bradford
PROBLEMS	*severe food shortage *poor location - swampy, limited drinking water supply *Native American hostility	*missed planting season *severe food shortage *Problems with local Native Americans
GOVERNMENT	Virginia House of Burgesses (1619) - first example of representative government in the colonies	Mayflower Compact (1620) - first example of self-government in the colonies
REASONS FOR SUCCESS	*cash crop tobacco *improved relations with the Native Americans * strong leadership of John Smith	*assistance with planting and generosity by the Native Americans *leads to the First Thanksgiving (1621)
